Gifts from Wills and Trusts

When making a charitable gift to a nonprofit organization, it is vital that the charity's legal name, address, and other identifying details be used. To name University of Alabama Huntsville Foundation in your will or trust, please use the following suggested language:

Residual Bequest Language

A residual bequest comes to us after your estate expenses and specific bequests are paid:

I give and devise to University of Alabama Huntsville Foundation, Huntsville, AL, (EIN 63-6048099) all (or state a percentage) of the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate, both real and personal, to be used for its general support (or for the support of a specific fund or program).

Specific Bequest Language

You can also name University of Alabama Huntsville Foundation as a beneficiary of a specific amount from your estate:	
I give and devise to University of Alabama Huntsville Foundation, Huntsville, AL, (EIN 63-6048099) the sum of \$ stock") to be used fits general support (or for the support of a specific fund or program).	
Contingent Bequest Language
